



- ➤ Students persist (across term and across year) to completion of their educational goals

New Student Orientation & Career Assessment

- Students are mandated to complete online and in person orientation
- Online orientation discusses the importance completing the career coach assessment checklist item PRIOR to attending in person orientation
- ➤ Total number of career coach assessments completed rose from 1,046 to 6,720 administrations over a six month period
- Career coach results subsequently used in mandatory student success course.




