

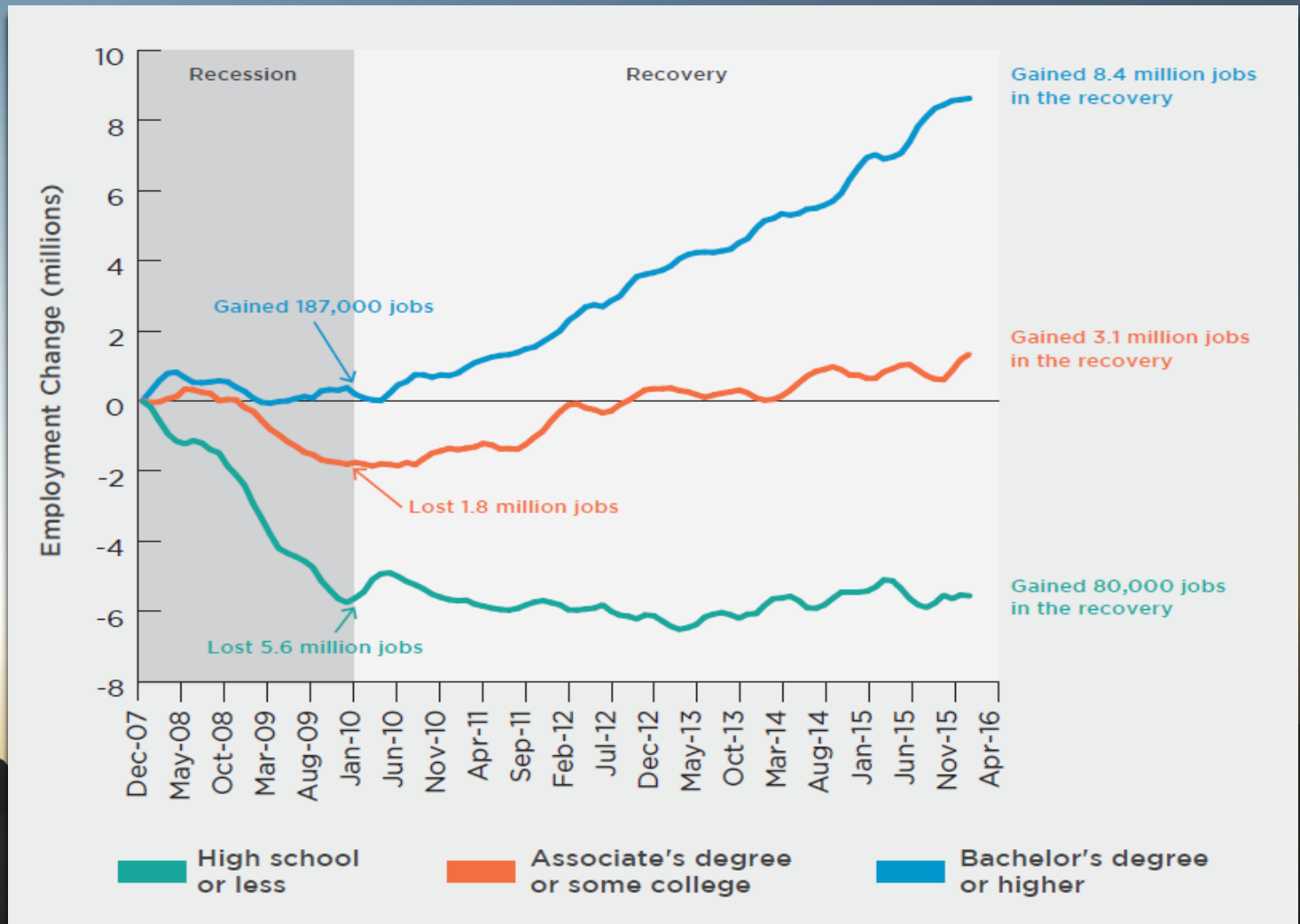


80 percent of jobs lost during the recession were those requiring a high school education or less.



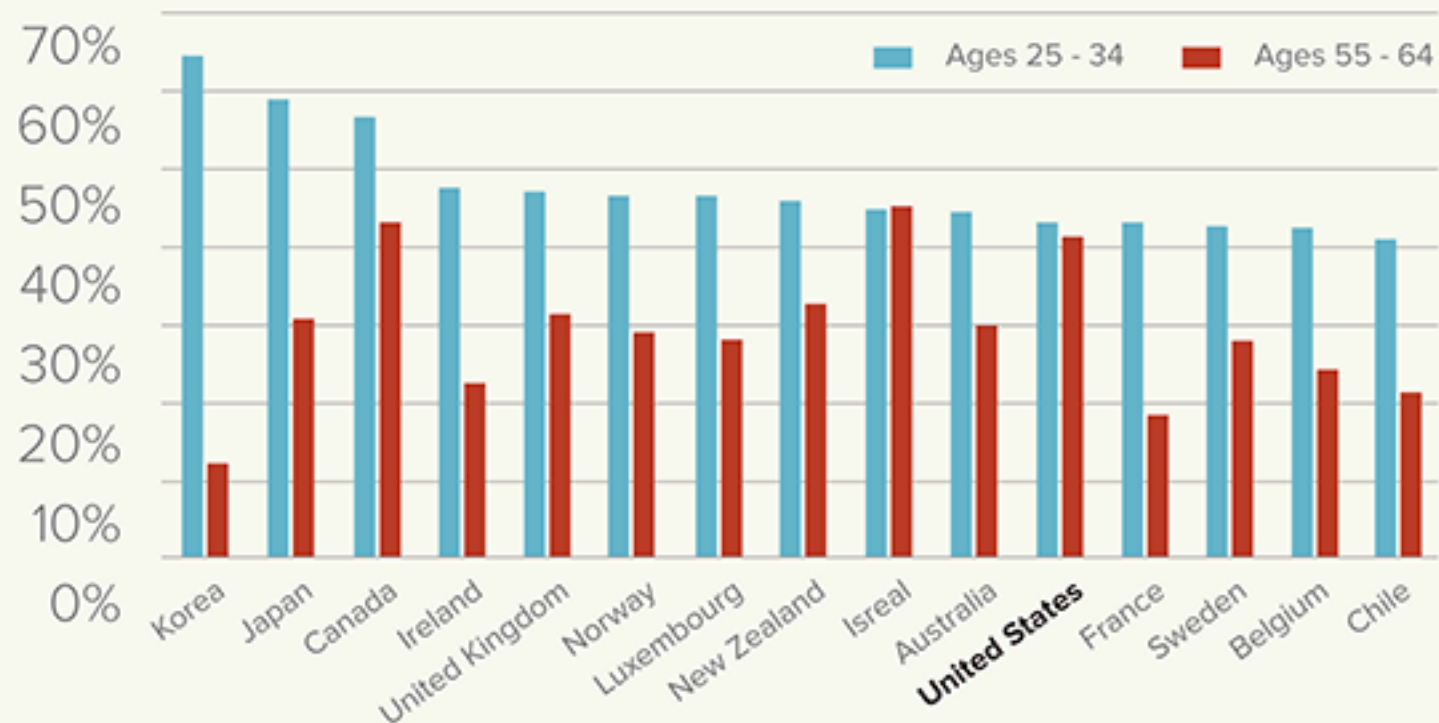
More than 60 percent of new jobs will require education or training beyond high school.

Attainment rates in the developed world



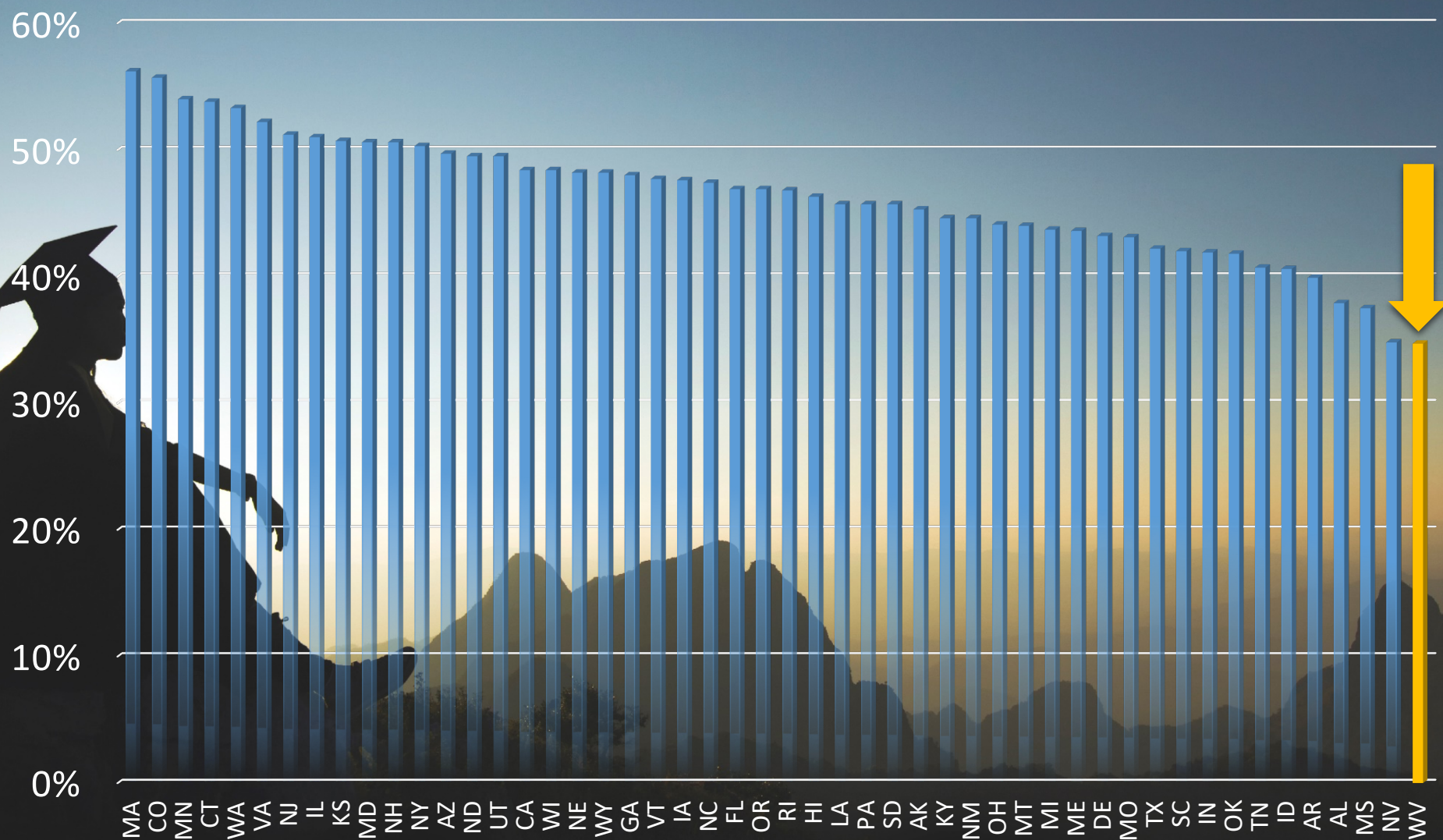

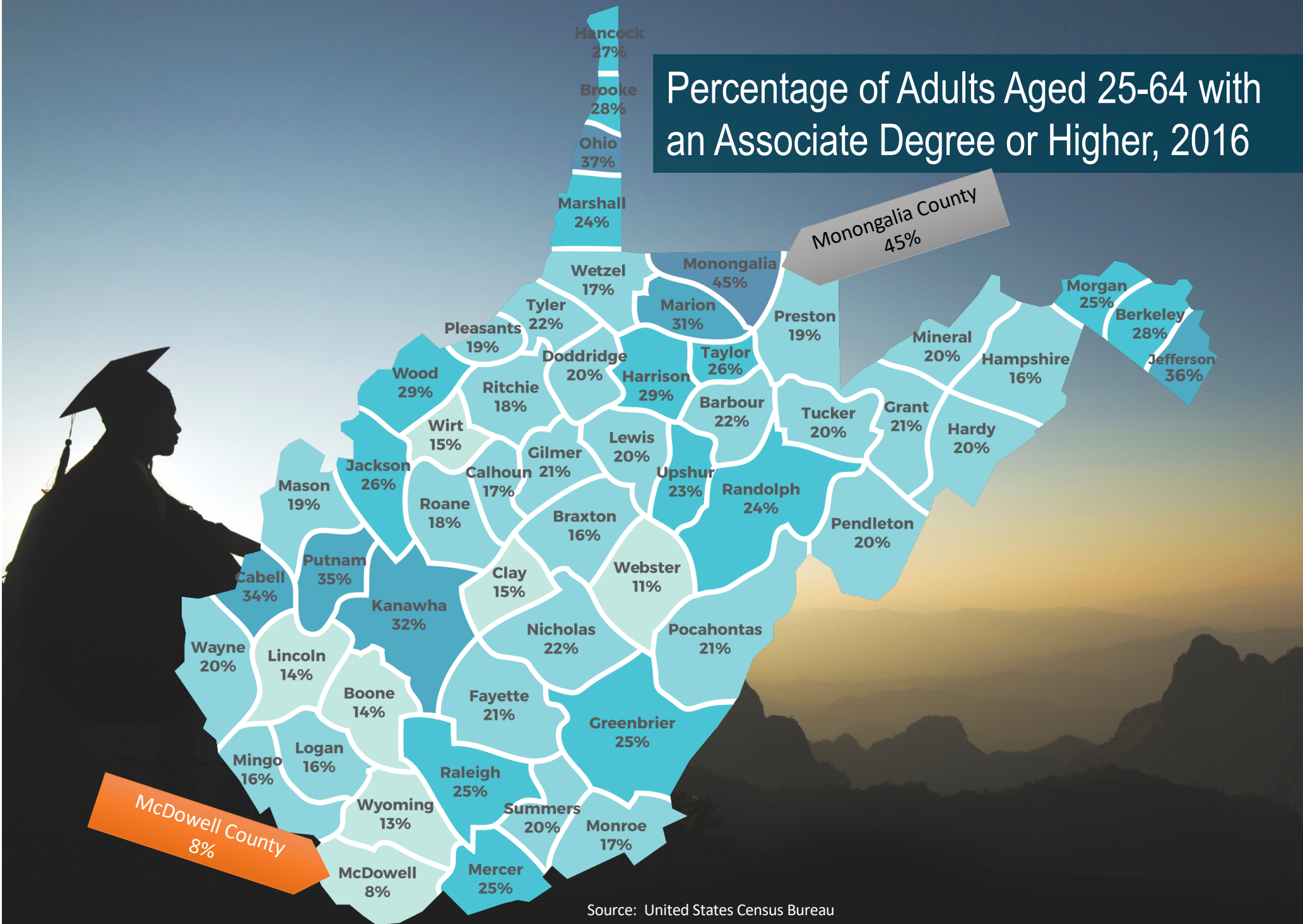

Postsecondary Attainment Rates by State



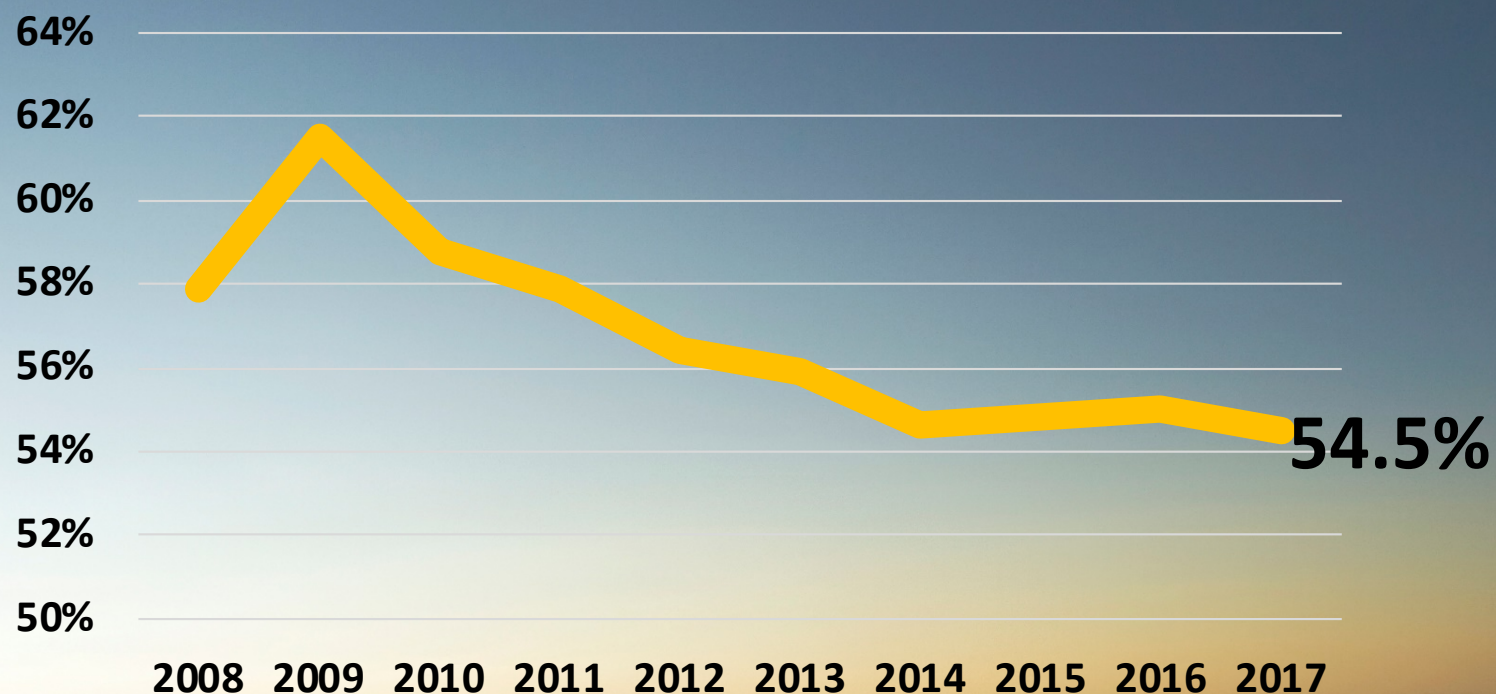

College-Going Rate of Recent WV High School Graduates

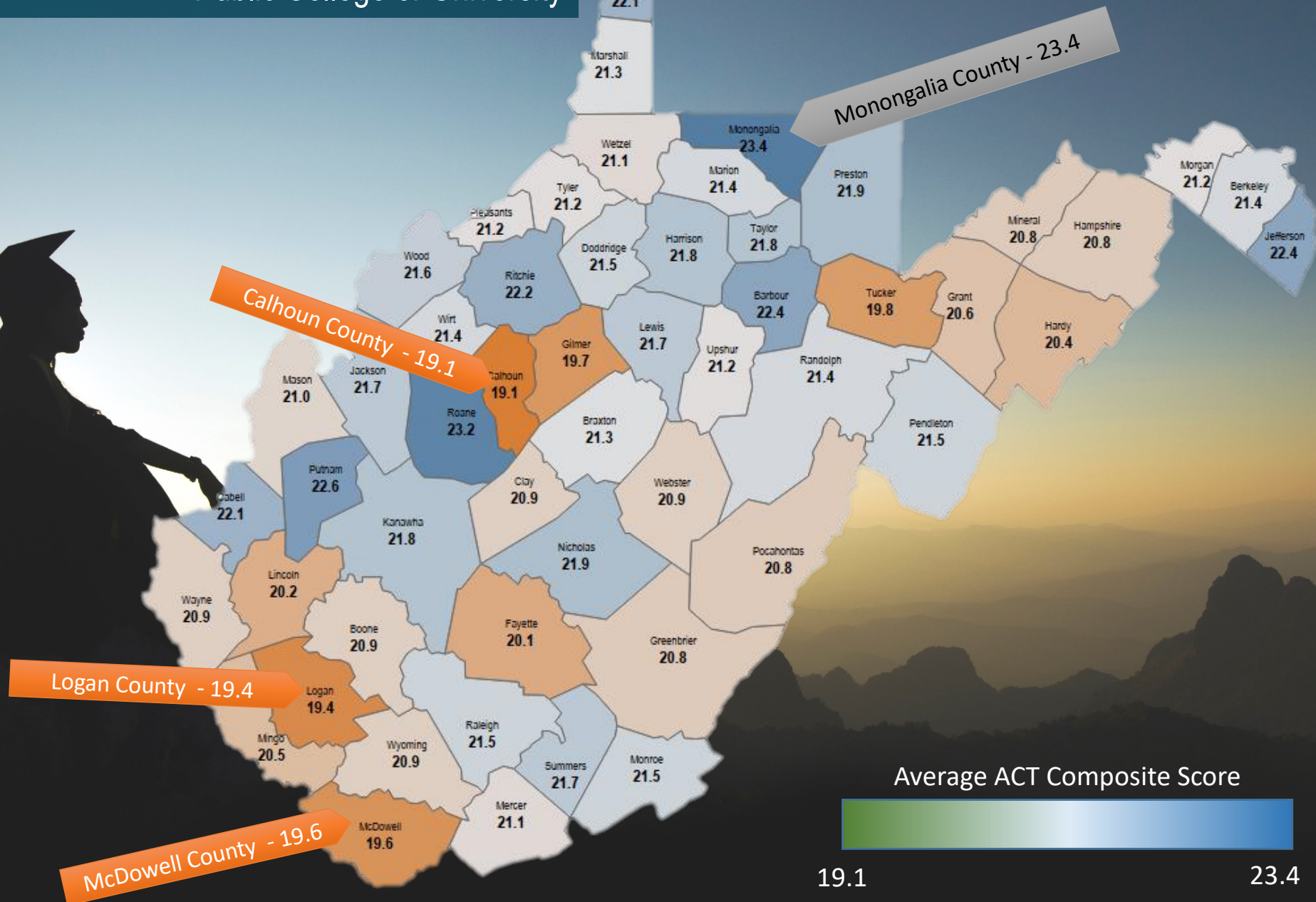

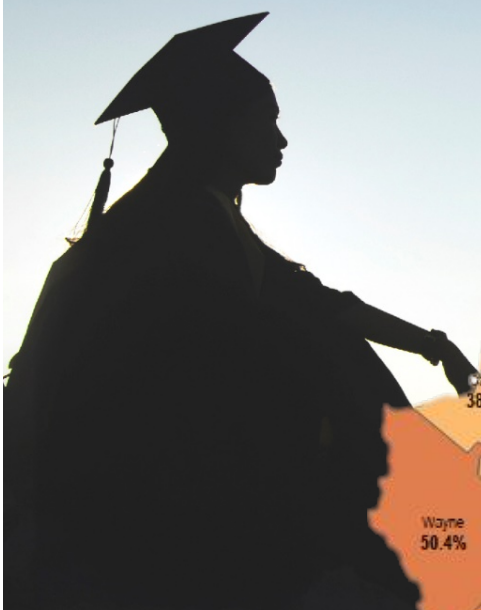

Average ACT Composite Scores of 2016 High School Graduates Enrolling at a West Virginia Public College or University

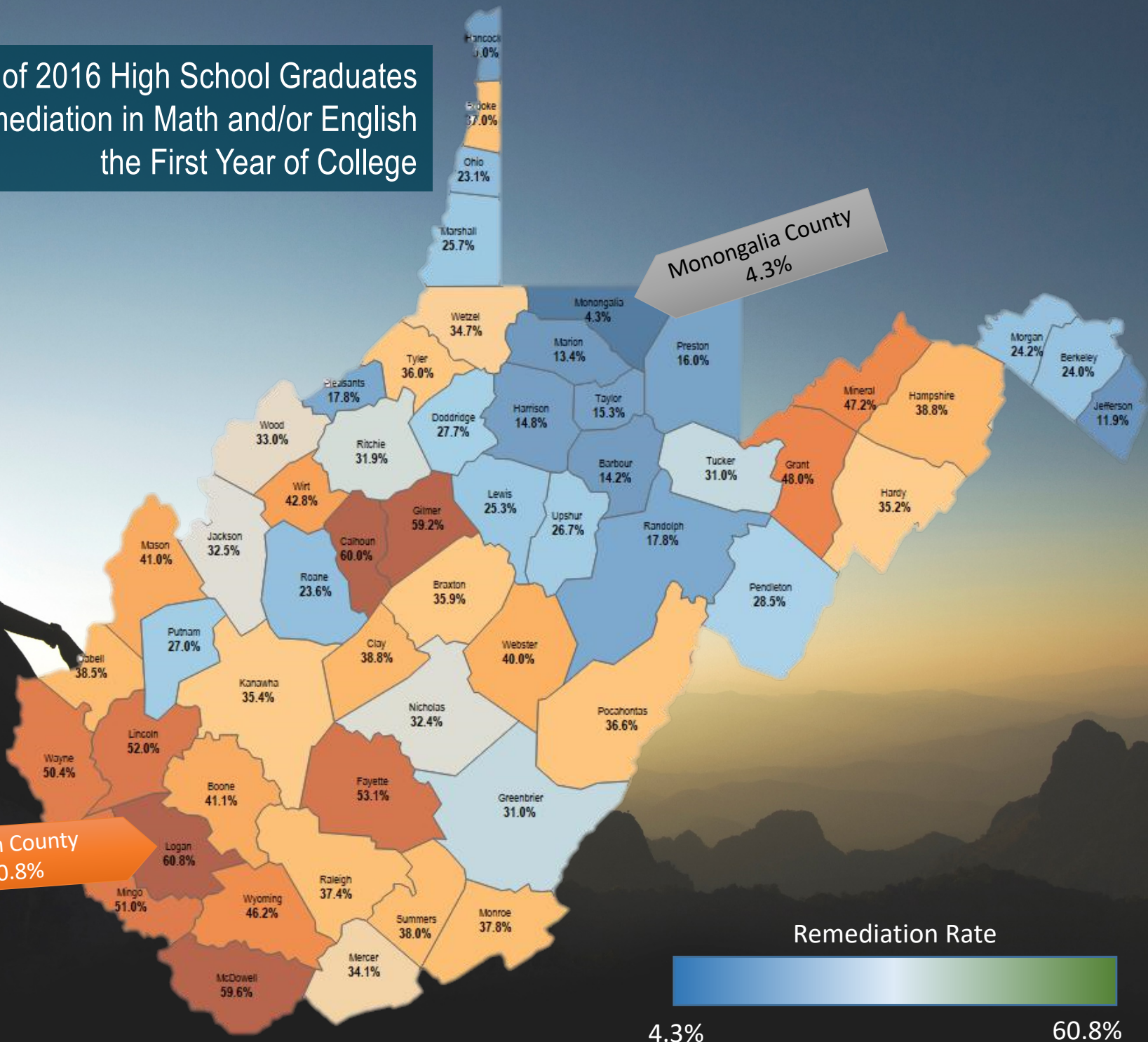


Percentage of 2016 High School Graduates Requiring Remediation in Math and/or English the First Year of College

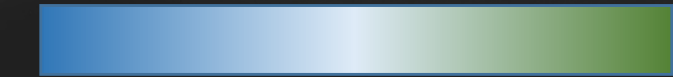

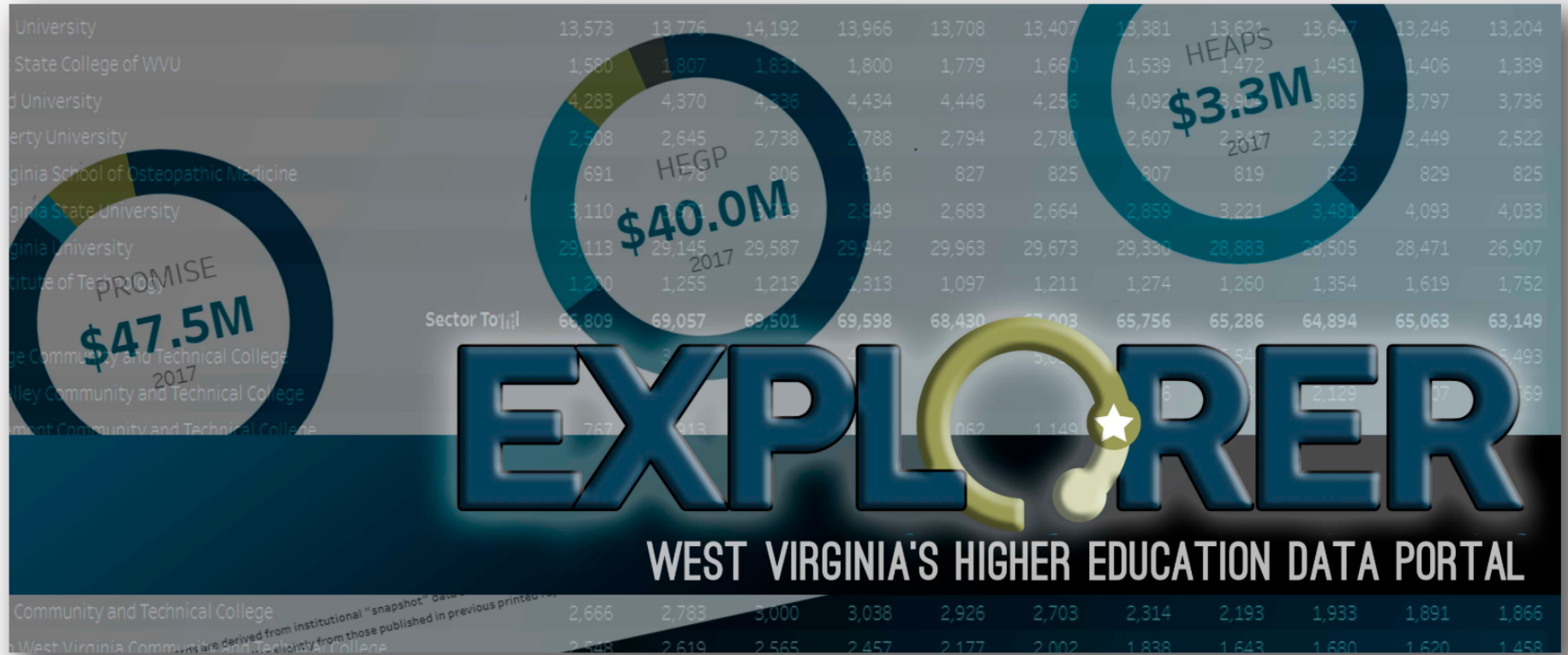

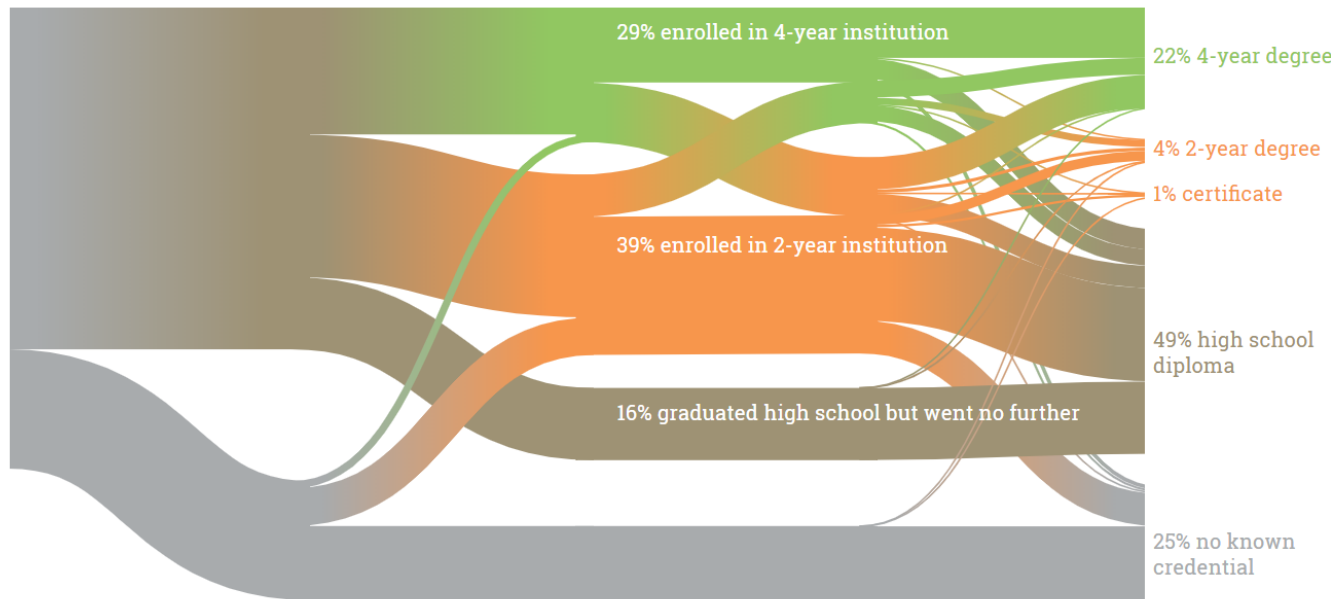
