Question	Answer(s)
How do course sharing courses impact the cumulative grade point average?	These are consortium courses rather than transfer courses. With transfer courses, only the credit transfers. With consortial courses, the grade applies and counts towards cumulative GPA.
Are these courses hosted through a specific LMS or is it connected to the home/teaching institution's LMS?	Consortial courses use the LMS of the teaching institution.
Are the courses available through the Consortium conducive with an Associate's Degree program?	There is a wide inventory of courses at both the undergrad and graduate level that can be leveraged to form pathways from Associate's and Bachelor's programs.
Will the courses be labeled as OER (zero materials cost) in the future?	This has recently been added as a functionality request for Acadeum Course Share.
How do you receive the final grade and midterm grades? Does the teaching institution need to access the home institution's database?	Grades are shared through the Acadeum course sharing platform directly for administrators to access and submit on their own student information system.
Who can join the CCA Course Sharing Consortium?	All systems and institutions within Alliance states can join the CCA Consortium, as well as institutions outside of Alliance states that have collaborated with CCA on different projects.
